BOOK REVIEW

Newspaper Indexes: a location and subject guide for researchers
by Anita Cheek Milner

This is a systematic attempt to provide a national list of indexed newspapers. It was compiled primarily for those who must conduct research by mail.

The book is in two parts. The first part is a listing of the newspapers indexed arranged by state, county and town where the paper was published. The dates of the time span the index covers and a symbol designating the index location are given. The second part lists 300 repositories, alphabetically by symbols. The information given under each listing includes the subjects indexed, cost (if any) of having an index searched, and charges for photocopying specific articles found in an index. Newspapers available through interlibrary loan are also noted. The complete address of each repository is given. Besides the categorization by state, county and town, there are also some listings for church publications, American foreign language papers, specialized subject and miscellaneous papers.

This book is a valuable tool for genealogists. It provides access to resources which have been available only to those with the time and means to travel to the repositories. Since the author obtained the information in this volume from questionnaires completed by the repositories, it can be assumed that they are willing and able to furnish service to users of this book. Anyone doing research by mail would do well to follow the advice given in the introduction. Using that advice and the information given in the book, researchers' chances of success should be greatly increased.

This book should be in the personal library of everyone who does research by mail. Mrs. Milner is continuing her research in this field and more of the same quality work is to be expected in the future.

In future issues of Leaves and Saplings, Twigs and Chips is planning to continue more of the Genealogies of Pioneer Families of San Diego County.
