WHEREAS, the San Diego Genealogical Society was founded 75 years ago on October 10th, 1946 at a meeting initiated by Mrs. Alicia Pearl Meyer. The meeting, held at high noon at the U.S. Grant Hotel in downtown San Diego was attended by Mrs. Elzoe C. Weissgerber and Mr. Paul Henry Goss.; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Genealogical Society began with 26 charter members in 1946, and continues to grow today with 427 active members; and

WHEREAS, the objective of the San Diego Genealogical Society is to promote interest in genealogy and family history research through individual and group effort and in cooperation with other organizations; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Genealogical Society supports the genealogical collection at the San Diego Public Library and the collection and preservation of genealogical and historical records of San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Genealogical Society provides in-person and virtual lectures and classes of genealogical interest; digital technology including genetic genealogy; social media; and writing and publishing of books, blogs and papers in the subject field; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Genealogical Society's dedicated volunteers provide valuable free research services, guidance, and assistance to the public and groups interested in pursuing genealogy and family history in San Diego; **NOW, THEREFORE,**
